

## Membership Terms and Conditions

1. All Discovery Centre memberships are non-refundable and non-transferable. All purchased memberships are limited to the adult individuals listed on the membership application.
2. Members visiting the Discovery Centre, and other partner science centres, should be prepared to show photo identification if requested.
3. Discovery Centre memberships are limited to residents of Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island. We encourage visitors to purchase a membership to their home science centre and to be used for free reciprocal admission to the Discovery Centre when they visit.
4. At the Discovery Centre, a family membership is defined as a member, their partner/spouse and their children. Dependent children are those 17 and under and living at the same address as the parents/guardians.
5. Children 12 and under must be accompanied by a parent/guardian or caregiver age 16 years or older on Discovery Centre premises at all times.
  - a. Children aged 13-17 may be permitted admission without adult supervision when the primary cardholder signs a waiver form that will be kept on file until membership expiry. Please inquire at the Front Desk for the waiver.
  - b. Children in this age category are not considered a supervisor of children 12 and under and will not be granted access to the Discovery Centre with younger children.
6. Lost or stolen membership cards will be replaced for a \$5 admission fee. Please notify the Front Desk team immediately if your card is lost or stolen.
7. Members need to have their cards and photo ID ready in order to gain fast entry during high peak times. Without a membership card, members must join the general admission line in order for the Front Desk team to look up membership details.
8. Member sneak peeks and special invites are designated for Member cardholders and their family. Guest passes are not acceptable for these events.
9. Members must purchase a Dome Theatre ticket at admissions, tickets are not guaranteed for members and cannot accommodate for sold out shows.
10. Membership cards are not valid for educational programs or group field trips.

## Membership Rates and Benefits

### **Innovator (\$200 +HST)**

These are valid for up to the three adults (18+) named on the application form. Two names shall be the primary users along with their two children. The third adult can be named, but also interchangeable for caregivers. Additional children and adults may be added for \$25 +HST each.

Caregivers can also be defined as a babysitter 16+ years of age, nanny, or grandparent.

### **Discoverer (\$125+HST)**

Memberships are valid for the two adults (18+) named on the application form and two children. Additional children and adults may be added for \$25 +HST each. Children under two years old do not count towards the two children on the membership card.

### **Explorer (\$100 +HST)**

Dedicated for families living in Prince Edward Island or 100km away from the Discovery Centre. Any communities included in the following locations are considered to be rural by our definition: Middle Musquodobit, Windsor, Chester, Shubenacadie and Ship Harbour. Please ask a member the Front Desk team if you are unsure.

Members may additional siblings for an additional \$10 +HST each. Children under two years old do not count towards the two children on the membership card.

### **Adventurer (\$50+HST)**

Valid for one adult (18+). One child may be added for \$25 +HST. Please ask the Front Desk team for more information.

\*Grandfathered memberships cannot be renewed and previous benefits will end upon renewal.

## Innovator Parking Pass Terms and Conditions

1. Members will be provided with one (1) parking pass per membership. The pass can only be used with the vehicles listed on the parking pass waiver. Members only permitted to use the parking pass with one (1) vehicle at a time and ensure the pass is clearly displayed from the review mirror or dashboard.
2. Members are permitted to access Nova Scotia Power's west parking Lot, located on the corner of Lower Water Street & Morris Street, for the sole purpose of visiting the Discovery Centre during the following times:
  - Monday – Friday 5:00PM-12:00AM
  - Saturday & Sunday 7:00AM-12:00AM
3. If a member's vehicle is found in the Nova Scotia Power west parking lot outside of hours outlined above, it may be ticketed or towed at owner's expense.
4. Parking privileges may be revoked, at any time, if it is found the privileges have been misused.
5. Members must report a lost or stolen parking pass immediately. It may take up to 3 weeks to receive a new pass.
6. The Discovery Centre has the right to terminate parking privileges with 30 days written notice.
7. Members are advised to use caution by crossing on crosswalks on Lower Water Street to travel to and from the Nova Scotia Power West Parking Lot to the Discovery Centre.
